




# Insurance



## Maintenance



Please refer to your tenancy agreement and schedule for guidance on maintaining your allotment plot. If you're ever unsure about making changes or adding anything to your plot, please contact the office before proceeding. Members of the Facilities Committee, along with the Clerk and Administrator, will carry out regular site reviews, up to four times a year. If you are experiencing any mitigating circumstances that may affect the condition of your plot, it is your responsibility to inform the Parish Council before a scheduled review. Tenants who are found to be in breach of their agreement will be contacted. The Parish Council will do its best to offer support, but please note resources are limited. Where necessary, allotment law will be followed in addressing continued non-compliance.



## Opening Hours



Open at 7am-10pm April to September and open 7am-9pm October to March. Allotment is accessible by car with Barrier key. Please relock green barrier after use, keep to driveway avoiding football pitches. No vehicle access on allotment grass in wet season.
